massive federal budget cuts mean cuts for states, cities and towns

Over 33% of all states' budgets are supported by federal funding, and some states receive as much as 50% of their budget from the federal government.

Put simply, federal budget cuts will devastate state and local budgets, which fund the work we do. We won't be able to negotiate contracts with strong wages and benefits.

States, cities and towns will be forced to make tough choices about what needs to be funded. That means *all public services and our jobs are on the line* – transportation, education, health care, sanitation, environmental protection, social services, child care, home care and beyond. *Everything will be on the chopping block*.
