Methodology: (1) Use OMB 2016 state allocations (FY 18 Budget: Tables 14-29 & 14-30) to estimate 2017 allocations & assume equal state shares of national totals in 2016, 2017, 2018; (2) Apply percentage cut from Trump's FY 18 national budget to each estimated state 2017 allocation.

***Note:** FY 18 is an abbreviation for Fiscal Year 2018, which runs October 1, 2017-September 30, 2018.
