



# Family Scholarship Program

AFSCME is currently accepting applications for the 2021 Family Scholarship Program. Ten scholarships of \$2,000 each will be awarded annually and renewed each year for a maximum of four years, and may be used for any field of study. Applications must be postmarked by December 31, 2020.

To be eligible for the scholarship, the applicant must:

- Be a graduating high school senior whose parent, legal guardian or financially responsible grandparent is a full dues-paying AFSCME member.
- At the time the scholarship is awarded, be enrolled in a full-time degree program either at an accredited four-year institution or at a two-year institution that will transfer credits to a four-year institution.
- Have taken the SAT or the ACT.
- Return complete application with all required documentation postmarked by the December 31, 2020 deadline.
